Mission Statement

In pursuit of excellence in care, development and education of young children in our community, Immanuel Christian Child Development Center, in partnership with families, will endeavor to promote and encourage Godliness and wisdom, while meeting physical, socio-emotional, mental and spiritual needs of the children in our care.

Goals and objectives:

- Modeling Godly character through quality childcare and education.
- Providing an atmosphere in which children can successfully achieve each developmental milestone.
- Enable children to enhance their physical, and cognitive development through Christ-centered curriculum.
- Guide, encourage and re-enforce healthy emotional and social behaviors of children toward peers and adults.
- Support families in understanding God's plan for them, by developing a family enrichment program.

Center opening hours:

Monday through Friday 6.30am-6.00pm

Center will be closed for the holidays. Holiday schedule will be available at the reception desk.

Staff- The center is staffed with Christian child development professionals. Staff includes a high academically qualified and internationally experienced director. Each classroom has a credentialed teacher and qualified assistant teacher based on the Title 22 ratios.

This involves:

Infants: 1 caregiver for every 4 infants

Toddlers: 1 caregiver for every 6 toddlers

Preschoolers: 1 caregiver for every 12 children

Infant and Toddler program offers primary care giving where a caregiver is responsible in providing basic care services and develop bonding with the child. We felt it necessary to provide primary care giving to this age group of children, as child development centers are extensions of homes. In each classroom a group of children are provided with a loving, responsible adult that meets the developmental needs. She also provides secure attachments with the children. As your child continues to be a student of ICCDC, he/she will move up in class with the same caregiver. This provides consistency in care giving and it also makes transitions easy for the child.

Curriculum:

The curriculum is planned with high expertise in order to provide developmentally appropriate experiences for children. Activities and experiences are planned for the total group, small groups and individuals. Each child will be given an opportunity to enhance his/her developing skills in different areas. The curriculum is flexible and child-centered. The teachers plan weekly and monthly themes for exploration and investigation by the children in their classroom. It is our steadfast belief that children must have the opportunity to form secure attachments within their environment. When secure attachments are formed, the child has the opportunity to work on other areas of development. Teacher is a model guide and focuses and scaffolding children's learning experience. The environment and activities that each teacher plans will provide excellent opportunities for the child to develop these skills which include loving, respecting, and caring for each other as God loved us, reasoning and problem solving, paying attention and concentration to task, healthy emotional expressions, fine and gross motor skills, reading, writing, and social skills that are necessary for future success in all walks of life.
