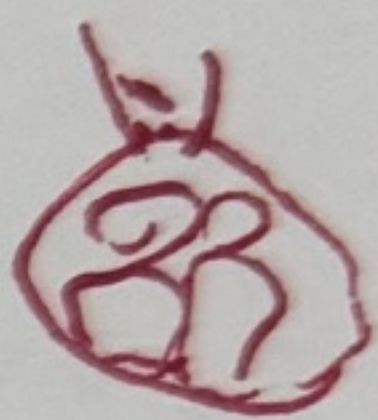
Dear CDC Families, Hope you all received the room change information regarding your child. Starting June 3rd children from Crib room, to Pre- kindergarten classroom will be moving up to a new classroom. The Asst /Assoc teacher moves up with the children to make the transition smooth for the children. Teacher assignments are based on the suitability and skills of the Teacher in handling a specific age group and also the Teacher's comfort level in working with a particular age group. Some children may be staying back in the old classroom depending on their age and developmental level. This whole transition initially will be moderately difficult and in a couple of weeks everything will become smooth both for the children and the staff. That is why we do these transitions in June instead of August. By the time school year starts, all children get adjusted to the new classroom and the routine.

During summer we have a very informal program as children settle down in the new rooms and adjust to the new environment. All parents must submit a non-prescription form on sun screen lotion to the classroom teacher. Foot wear must be comfortable closed shoes. No Flip flops or sandals please. Leave an extra pair of clothes as children may need to change their clothes if they wet the clothes during water play.

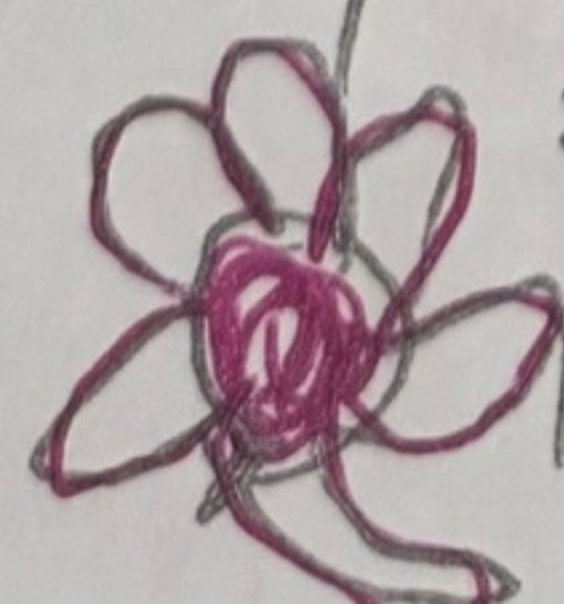
The Summer program ends on August 2nd with bounce houses and open house for all families starting at 8 am and ends at 12 noon.

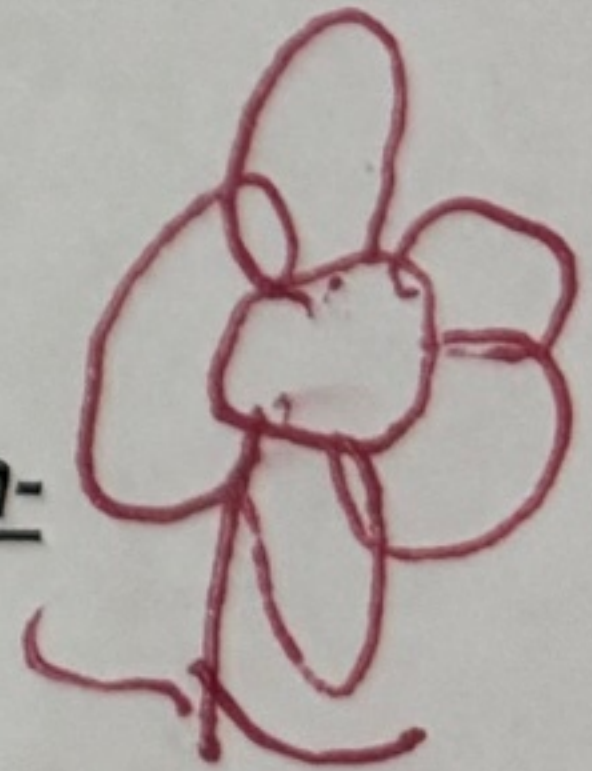
